Sao Sok Kornn is a 16 year-old-student in the 8th grade at The Kozak Ohana School #285 in Lvea Village, Chey Commune, Kampong Svay District, Kampong Thom Province, Cambodia.

Sok Kornn has two siblings and is the second child in the family. Her elder sister stopped attending school after primary school, and her younger brother is only two years old. Sok Kornn's parents do not own any land, so work in other rice field to earn an income. As this job does not pay very much, Sok Kornn and her family live in poverty. As her family does not own land, the family has to harvest rice from crops that other farmers have left behind. The family is able to get 50kg of rice per year from this, which cannot support the family's needs for long. In turn, her father occasionally works as a fisherman to earn an income for food and to support his daughter's studies. Currently, Sok Kornn rides a bike to school every day, which is approximately 4 kilometers one way, and yet she is always on time for school and eager to learn.
