Sira Sreylan is 12 years old, studying grade five at Masako Sato School in Putreng village, Dakdam commune, Orang district and Mondukiri province.

There are five members in Sreylan's family. She has two brothers, her parents and herself. She is the second child in the family. Her parents are farmers they have very small farmland it is less than half hectare and they planting cassava. This farmland can produce about 2.5 to 3 tons of cassava per year. Her parent had rented a house at the village because of their home is at the farm and far away from school. Her family has loaned some money from the bank and they have to pay back \$120 every months. Sreylan's mother is a seller at the village. The profit selling is about 60,000 riels per day but it is not regular income. Her father works as a construction worker, he can earn 40,000 riels in a working day, if no construction work, he does other works such as a cassava carry worker during harvest season and earn about 50,000 per working day. Her father works everything that he can and he has never kept his time run out. Sreylan said, the above earning is not enough to provide the family because they have to pay to the bank, pay to the rent, buy rice, and pay for electricity and water as well. Sreylan helps her mother while her mother is busy and help to house work after school.

In the future, Sreylan wants to be sale-women because; she wants to earn more of money to help her family.
